

## Jungle Trip Visiting Elephant Camp in Bago Yoma (June 2013 – March 2014)

### Plan 1: Day trip to Bago Yoma Jungle and Visit Elephant Camp

#### Detail Schedule:

Get up early in morning and leave Taungoo about 6:00 am drive to elephant camp (3 hr) and learn how elephants are working for the logging process (at real elephant working sites). Have lunch in the jungle and come back to Taungoo in the afternoon (arrive around 4 or 5 pm).

### Plan 2: Trip to Elephant Camp and Karen Village (One Overnight)

#### Daily Schedule:

**Day 1:** Leave Taungoo in the morning about 8:00 am and off-road driving (2hr) to Karen village. Visit Karen village and study old Karen tradition and learn how they have to struggle to survive in the jungle. Have lunch and drive to elephant camp (1hr) and overnight at the camp (real working camps).



**Day 2:** Get up early morning and follow the elephant master (Oo Zi) to chase his elephant which was freed in to the jungle for the whole night and learn how elephants are working for the logging process. Have lunch and drive back to Taungoo (3hr) in the afternoon.

### Plan 3: Trip to Elephant Camp and Karen Village (Two Overnights)

#### Daily Schedule:

**Day 1:** Leave Taungoo in the morning and off-road driving to Karen village (6hr) and study old Karen tradition and learn how they have to struggle to survive in the jungle. Overnight at the village.



**Day 2:** Visit the village in the morning and have lunch and then cross jungle drive to elephant camp (3hr). Overnight at the elephant camp,

**Day 3:** Get up early morning and follow the elephant master (Oo Zi) to chase his elephant which was freed in to the jungle for the whole night and learn how elephants are working for the logging process. Have lunch and drive back to Taungoo (3hr) in the afternoon.

**Plan 4: Off-road Cross-jungle Trip (One Overnight in jungle)**

**Detail Schedule: 4.1 (Taungoo to Pyay)**

**Day 1 :** Leave Taungoo about 6:00 am drive to elephant camp (3 hr) and learn how elephants are working for the logging process (at the real elephant working site). Have lunch in the elephant camp, and then drive to Karen village (3hr). Overnight at Karen village,



**Day 2:** Visit village in the morning, have lunch and then drive to Pyay.

**Detail Schedule: 4.2 (Pyay to Taungoo)**

**Day 1:** Leave Pyay about 8:00 am drive to Karen village (4 hr) and study old Karen tradition and learn how they have to struggle to survive in the jungle. Have lunch and drive to elephant camp in afternoon (3hr). Overnight at the elephant camp,

**Day 2:** Get up early morning and follow the elephant master (Oo Zi) to chase his elephant which was freed in to the jungle for the whole night and learn how elephants are working for the logging process. Have lunch and drive back to Taungoo (3hr) in the afternoon.

**Plan 5: Off-road Cross-jungle Trip (two overnights in jungle)**

**Detail schedule: 5.1 (Taungoo to Pyay)**

**Day 1:** Leave Taungoo about 8:00 am and drive to elephant camp (3hr). Have lunch at the elephant camp. Overnight at the elephant camp,



**Day 2:** Get up early and learn how elephants are working for the logging process (at real elephant working sites). Have lunch and off-road cross jungle trip from the elephant camp to Karen village (3hr), study old Karen tradition and learn how they have to struggle to survive in the jungle. Overnight at Karen village.

**Day 3:** Off-road trip from Karen village to Pyay.

**Detail schedule: 5.2 (Pyay to Taungoo)**

**Day 1:** Start from Pyay around 9 am and drive to Karen village (4hr). Have lunch at Karen village and study old Karen tradition and learn how they have to struggle to survive in the jungle. Overnight at Karen village,

**Day 2:** Have a walk around the village in the morning and drive to elephant camp around 10am (3hr). Have lunch at the elephant camp. Overnight at the elephant camp,

**Day 3:** Get up early morning and follow the elephant master (Oo Zi) to chase his elephant which was freed in to the jungle for the whole night and learn how elephants are working for the logging process. Have lunch and drive back to Taungoo (3hr) in the afternoon.

Please note that we will charge cancellation fees accordingly and guide rate (30 USD/pax/day for standard trips and 60 USD/pax/day for superior trips).

We need special permission (Kar Lon permission) to visit really working elephant camps. This permission have to be done by agencies and the above rates doesn't include the cost for it. If it is not possible to arrange that permission, please let us know and we will help you arrange it with an extra charge.

All above rates are in USD per person and this include accommodation (school or monastery type with beds on floor in a hall and common toilet) and transport in jungle (four-wheel drive for superior trips and normal two wheel drive car for standard trips), guiding fees, entrance fees, elephant fees and meals. Note: The term 'elephant camp' refers to a small village where the families of the elephant people are staying.

Sometimes, depending on the camp we are visiting, we may have an opportunity to offer private rooms for our clients. In this case, clients are supposed to stay in double or triple depending on rooms. If there is any person who wants to stay in single, please let us know in ahead and we will collect 20 USD/ person/ night.

All reservations should make at least 2 weeks prior to the trip together with names, nationalities, passport numbers, visa numbers, visa type, the date of entry to Myanmar and date of birth of the clients. The cancellation of the trip or change of the client number should make at least 1 week prior to the trip and please note that if there is change in the number of clients, the rate will be changed accordingly. And if the reservation is cancelled within 1 week, we will charge 25% of total cost as canceling fee and 50% within 3 days and 100% within 24 hr or during trip. Please let us know if there will be guides accompanying clients and please forgive us if we would have to leave the guide according to the space on the vehicle.
